

Programme Structure

Students study 3 subject modules alongside (i) an English language module and (ii) a skills-based module

Subjects offered for a study pathway into Business, Economics, Finance or Entrepreneurship courses at university:

- ✓ Economics
- ✓ Maths for Business
- ✓ Business Studies
- ✓ Global Studies

Subjects offered for a pathway into Medicine or healthcare degrees:

- ✓ Biology
- ✓ Chemistry
- ✓ Plus Mathematics (above)

English for Academic

Purposes is mandatory for all students with IELTS 5.0 or equivalent. EAP is in place of the requirement for an IELTS test score and is accepted by partner universities. EAP is worth 40 credits.

Skills-based module is studied online within IFY and develops essential academic skills and transferable skills like the Eight Traits mentioned early. (Module worth 5 credits)

IFY will be assessed using a mix of coursework & exams.

Duration:

The standard programme is 1 academic year starting in September. However, an accelerated 6-month option and a part-time two-year option are also available:

- ✓ 18 hours per week (12 hours for subject modules; 6 hours for EAP)
- ✓ 540 hours of guided learning + 660 hours of independent study (1,200 learning hours)
- ✓ Over 30 weeks (divided into two 15-week semesters)
